All of the counties in Washington have produced gold. East of the Cascades, the most noteworthy are Stevens, Ferry, Okanogan, Chelan, and Kittitas Counties. Stevens County is in the far Northeast corner of the state. Hundreds of mine sites are scattered throughout the area, often lode mines that also produced copper, iron, etc.

PANNING IN WASHINGTON. The state's streams that contain placer gold are also important for the plant and animal communities they support. To protect stream and streamside habitats, the Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife (DFW) administers the Hydraulics Code (RCW 75.20.100).

Washington Gold Maps. Our Washington Gold Maps show there are currently 3,041 active gold claims and 52,397 abandoned gold claims located throughout the state. Of those active claims, 2,744 are lode claims and 297 are placer claims. Of those abandoned claims, 48,820 are lode and 3,577 are placer.

Currently, Washington has several permitted metal mines, but only one of them is operational—the Buckhorn Mountain gold mine in Okanogan County, managed by Kinross Gold Corporation. The mines shown are by no means all of the metallic mines in Washington. The remainder of the mines

existed prior to the Metals Mining and Milling Act was signed.
